

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, H. W. Currin and Laura E. Currin (Name of applicant) of Hillsboro (Post office), County of Washington, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is no name an unnamed stream (Name of stream), a tributary of Tualatin River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .18 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 330 ft. N. and 1320 ft. W. from the SE corner of Sec. 12, T. 1 S., R. 3 W. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 2 ft. feet, length on top 8 ft. feet, length at bottom 3 ft. feet; material to be used and character of construction dirt (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed Stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 1, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 11, 1945 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1946 Extended to Oct. 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1947 Extended to Oct. 1, 1947
