CERTIFICATE NO. 15330

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Howard L. & Katie C. Ash (Name of applicant) of Trail (Post office), County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Spring in Elk Creek watershed (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 517 ft. S (N. or S.) and 115 ft. W (E. or W.) from the NW 1/4 corner of Section 27 (Section or subdivision)

being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 28, Tp. 32 S (N. or S.), R. 1 E, W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The pipe (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 900 feet (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 27, Tp. 32 S (N. or S.)

R. 1 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction spring boxed in by 2 x 2 x 4 ft. concrete box. (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate direct from spring into pipe (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

** Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydro-electric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 24, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 1, 1946 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1948
