* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Theodore Hilton Turner (Name of applicant) of Grants Pass, R#1, Box 192 (Post office), County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Turner Spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic, including garden (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 800 ft. S (N. or S.) and 1200 ft. E (E. or W.) from the NE 1/4 corner of section 24 (Section or subdivision)

being within the NW 1/4, NE 1/4 of Sec. 24, Tp. 36 S (N. or S.), R. 5 W (E. or W.), W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The pipe line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 1500 feet (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 24, Tp. 36 S (N. or S.), R. 5 W (E. or W.), the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam Sump feet, length on top 3 feet, length at bottom 3 feet; material to be used and character of construction vitrified pipe (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, 3 feet diam. placed 3 feet deep in sump. rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Turner Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic, including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre domestic garden.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 11, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 1, 1946 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1948
