

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, D. & W. Lumber Co. Glen Davis and Guy Wood (Name of applicant) of Sutherlin (Post office), County of Douglas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Camas Swale (Name of stream), a tributary of Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.90 cubic feet per second. one source (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is log pond & manufacturing (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 462 ft. N and 924 ft. W from the corner of Center of Sec. 20, T. 25 S. R. 5 W. Willamette Meridian (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.90 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Camas Swale and log pond to be constructed under Application No. R-20419, Permit No. R-805

The use to which this water is to be applied is log pond and manufacturing

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 25, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 1, 1946 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1948
