

\* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Jay Porter (Name of applicant) of Rogue River (Post office), County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Evans Creek and reservoir (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.20 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 288 ft. N and 2594 ft. W from the East 1/4 corner of Section 4 (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 4, Tp. 36 S, R. 4 W, W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The pipe and ditch to be 1/4 mile in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 4, Tp. 36 S, R. 4 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 2 feet, length on top 30 feet, length at bottom 20 feet; material to be used and character of construction concrete and rock (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate pump (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 5" Fairbanks Morse Centrifugal powered by 30 H. P. Diesel (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

\* A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

\*\* Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydro-electric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Evans Creek and reservoir  
to be constructed under Application No. R-20628, Permit No. R-809.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per  
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be  
further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre  
irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year from  
direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R-809.  
and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 4, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 16, 1946 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before  
October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1948
