

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Cleo and Selma Johnson (Name of applicant) of Medford, Route 4, Box 77 (Post office), County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed spring in Bear Creek (Name of stream) Watershed, a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 368 ft. S and 1220 ft. E from the N1/4 corner of Section 21 (Section or subdivision)

being within the NW1/4 NE1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 37 S, R. 1 W, W. M., in the county of Jackson (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The pipe line to be 350 feet (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NW1/4 NE1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 37 S, R. 1 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, Spring boxed in with laid rock 4 x 8 x 4 ft. rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate direct from spring (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 3/4" Myers Piston Pump powered by 1/4 H.P. Century electric motor. (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.) 25 ft. total head.

** Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydro-electric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic, including the irrigation of a garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 8, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 16, 1946 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1948
