APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

We, Geo. C Spencer and J M Spencer (Name of Applicant.)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Bon-Miller Creek, Tributary of Bear Creek which is tributary to Rogue River (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one-half cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable system of rotation ordered by the proper State officers. The priority date of this permit is Apr. 19, 1913.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 5/8 cubic feet per second. or its equivalent in case of rotation.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Aug 20 1914 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1st, 1915

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct 1st, 1916
