To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Earl T. White (Name of applicant) of Jacksonville, Box 34, (Mailing address) State of ... do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed gulch, (Name of stream) tributary of Little Applegate, a tributary of Big Applegate

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 3 feet, length on top 10 feet, length at bottom 5 feet; material to be used and character of construction dirt and rock (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

STATE OF OREGON, } ss County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed Gulch

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic, including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre domestic gardens.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 26, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 1, 1946 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1948
