To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, C. A. and Myrtle L. Candy (Name of applicant) of Gold Hill Rt. 1 (Mailing address), State of Ore., do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Moore Gulch (Name of stream) trib. Middle Fk. Fooths Creek, a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.025 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1233 ft. S. and 759 ft. E. from the corner of Sec. 13 (Section or subdivision)

being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 37 S., R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The ditch and pipeline to be 1480 in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 37 S., R. 4 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

STATE OF OREGON, } ss County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Moore Gulch

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 12, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1946 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1948
