

\* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. H. Wallis (Name of applicant) of Ashland, Rt. 1 Box 507 (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Wallis Spring (Name of stream) in Jenny Creek Watershed, a tributary of Klamath River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and garden (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 920 ft. S and 1300 ft. E from the NW corner of Section 27 (Section or subdivision)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)

being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 27, Tp. 40 S, R. 4 E, W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The Pipe Line to be 2900 feet in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 27, Tp. 40 S, R. 4 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Wallis Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic, including irrigation of not  
to exceed 1/2 acre domestic gardens.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per  
second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 20, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1946 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before  
October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before  
October 1, 1948
