

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Gilbert Courtright, of La Grande, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Catherine Creek, a tributary of Grande Ronde River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2.5 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 500 ft. east from the center of the Northwest quarter of Section Four Township 4 S.R. 39 N.W.M.

being within the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 4, Tp. 4 SR, R. 39 E, W. M., in the county of Union

5. The Ditch to be 1/2 mile in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 4, Tp. 4 SR, R. 39 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 3 ft., length on top 20 ft., feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction earth and wood

(b) Description of headgate Wood box

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description

* A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Catherine Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 2, 1946

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 18, 1947 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1949
