To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Mrs. Dorathea B. Flynn ~~Parmenter~~ (Name of applicant) of Medford (Mailing address), Hotel Medford State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rexrood springs No. 1 & No. 2 (Name of stream) Evans Creek Watershed, a tributary of East Fork Evans Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.04 cubic feet per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. from both springs (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic and stock. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1125 ft. N. and 450 ft. W. from the E1/4 corner of Section 21 from No. 1 Spring and 775 ft. S. and 750 ft. W. from the N.E. corner of Section 21 from No. 2 Spring. (Section or subdivision)

Diversion Works—

STATE OF OREGON, } ss County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Rexrood springs No. 1 and No. 2.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and stock being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock from south spring and 0.02 c.f.s. for stock from north spring.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 28, 1946

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1947 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1949
