* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Stella K. Johnson (Name of applicant) of O'Brien (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Elk Cr. to W. Fk. Illinois River

Beginning at a point where the West side of the Redwood Highway intersects the South boundary line of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 14 Township 41 South Range 9 West of the Willamette Meridian in Josephine County, Oregon and run thence West along said boundary line a distance of about 240 feet to the break of a swale, thence along the break of said swale to a fir tree marked with an "X"; thence North to center of Dwight Creek; thence down the center of Dwight Creek to the Redwood Highway; thence Southerly along the boundary line of the Redwood Highway to the place of beginning, containing 5 acres more or less and taking in all of the flat land between the swale and the Highway.

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic supplies and auto court

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per
