

* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Everett E. Robinson (Name of applicant) of P.O. Box 667 (Mailing address), Grants Pass, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Applegate River (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 600 ft. S and 850 ft. E from the W 1/4 corner of Section 15 (Section or subdivision)

being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 37 S, R. 6 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The ditch to be 4 miles in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 6, Tp. 37 S, R. 6 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 2 feet, length on top 50 feet, length at bottom 50 feet; material to be used and character of construction Earth and Brush. Wasteway over. (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Timber. One opening 4' x 6' (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 12" centrifugal 20 H.P. electric motor, 10 ft. lift. (Pump and motor have been installed by the Wilderville Ditch Company.)

**Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

Description: The East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 6, in Township 37, South Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, containing 80 acres more or less.

Less and excepting therefrom a parcel of land, beginning at the Southwest corner of Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of said Section 6 and run thence East 8 rods; thence North 10 rods; thence West 8 rods; thence South 10 rods to the point of beginning containing one-half acres.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Applegate River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 10, 1946

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1947 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1949
