

\* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT CERTIFICATE NO. 19450

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, P. O. Ottaway (Name of applicant) of Aurora (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is Stock and Domestic, including irrigation  
of 1/2 acre domestic lawn and garden being 0.01 c.f.s. for each use.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ..... of one cubic foot per  
second .....

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 25, 1946

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 15, 1947 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1948

October 1, 1949
