This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The use of water hereunder is limited to domestic supply

The priority date of this permit is June 26, 1913

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed one-tenth (1/10) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Oct 14, 1914

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1915

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct 1, 1916
