To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, P. J. Peltier (Name of applicant) of Swisshome (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed stream (Name of stream) trib. of Lake Creek, a tributary of Siuslaw River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.08 cubic feet per second. being 0.07 c.f.s. for irrig. & 0.01 c.f.s. for dom. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.) and domestic

4. The point of diversion is located 1500 ft. E and 150 ft. W from the NE corner of Sec. 16, T. 17 S., R. 9 W., W. M. (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)

being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 17 S, R. 9 W, W. M., in the county of Lane (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 3 feet, length on top 6 feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction concrete (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description gravity (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

STATE OF OREGON, County of Marion, ss

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and supplemental irrigation, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.07 c.f.s. for supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water ~~allowed~~ allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 26, 1946

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 1, 1947 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1949
