

# APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mill Creek & Goodrich Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 25 cubic feet per second.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This appropriation, together with all waters herebefore appropriated for the irrigation of these lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State officers. The priority date of this permit is July 28, 1913.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed Nineteen & 5/10 or its equivalent in case of cubic feet per second. rotation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Oct 14, 1914 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1st, 1916

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct 1st 1918
