\* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R.E. Mc Manus (Name of applicant) of Gold Hill (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Old Mining tunnel (Name of stream) Foots Creek Watershed, a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.02 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic and fire protection (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1649.7 ft. S. and 2498. ft. E. from the N.W. corner of Sec. 12, or: S. 56° 34' E. 2993 feet from the N.W. corner of section 12. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

STATE OF OREGON, } ss County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an old mining tunnel

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and fire protection

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 5, 1946

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 1, 1947 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1949
