* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Garcia Lbr. Co. (by T. L. Garcia, owner) of P. O. Box #741, Wolf Creek State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Coyote Creek, a tributary of Wolf Creek to Grave Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.20 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is mill pond

4. The point of diversion is located 450 ft. N and 1200 ft. W from the SE corner of section 24

being within the SE 1/4 of Sec. 24, Tp. 33 S, R. 6 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The pipe line to be 200 feet in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of Sec. 24, Tp. 33 S, R. 6 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 1 feet, length on top 20 feet, length at bottom 20 feet; material to be used and character of construction

Earth dam. Wasteway over rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam

(b) Description of headgate Valve in 2" pipe

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 2" centrifugal pump

2 3/4 H. P. Gas motor. 10 foot lift

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Coyote Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is pond

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 15, 1946

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 1, 1947 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1949
