* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Frederick A. Diem and Rose Diem (Name of applicant) of Box 204 (Mailing address), Merlin, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Jump-Off Joe Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.05 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 500 ft. S. and 2100 ft. W from the NE corner of Section 20 (Section or subdivision)

5. The pipe and ditch to be 500 feet in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 20, Tp. 35 S, R. 6 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

Remarks: Description: Commencing at the center of Section 20, Township 35 South, Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, said point of beginning being the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of said Section, and run thence East along the South line of said Northeast Quarter a distance of 990 feet; thence North a distance of 1450 feet to the County Road known as the Merlin-Galice County Road; thence West along the South line of said County Road a distance of 990 feet to the West line of said Northeast Quarter of said Section; and thence South along the West line of said Northeast Quarter a distance of 1550 feet to the point of beginning, containing thirty-four (34) acres, more or less, in the Northeast Quarter of said Section.

Also, beginning at the point of intersection of the West line of said Northeast Quarter with the North line of said County Road; and run thence East along the North line of said County Road a distance of 586 feet; thence North 516 feet to the South bank of Jump-Off Joe Creek; thence following the south bank of said Creek Westerly to the intersection of said South Bank of said Creek with the West line of said Northeast Quarter; and thence South along said West line of said Northeast Quarter 320 feet to the point of beginning.

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON, } ss County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Jump-Off Joe Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 7, 1946

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 1, 1947 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1949
