

\* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Yachats Water District, of Yachats, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation. A municipal corporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Reedy Creek, a tributary of Yachats River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2.0 cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Municipal.

4. The point of diversion is located 0 ft. and 50 ft. from the corner of N. 55° 16' E. 2839.4 feet from the W 1/4 corner of Section 31, T. 11 S., R. 11 W., W.M.

being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 31, Tp. 11 S., R. 11 W., W. M., in the county of Lincoln.

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON, } ss County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Reedy Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Municipal (all of the purposes for which water could be used in a city under a right initiated for municipal use)

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 9, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 31, 1947 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1949
