APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, A P Snyder (Name of Applicant.)

of Dayville (Postoffice), County of Grant

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a living and perpetual spring (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one twentieth cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supplies (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located S 57° 17' W 73.9 Chains from NE 1/4 cor Sec 1. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NW of SE of Sec. 1, Tp. 12 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

5. The pipe line to be 200.0 ft. in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. One, Tp. 12 S, R. 26 E (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:
