Beginning at an iron pipe on the West line of John Nyberg's land in Section 2μ , T. 2 S.R. 1 W. Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon, the said beginning point bears West 2730.0 feet and North O deg. 10' East μ 30.0 feet from the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner on the East line of said Section 2μ , and being the North East corner of land owned by the Tualatin Mill Company, running thence North O deg. 10' along the West line of said John Nyberg's land 276.0 feet more or less to the North East corner of Albert C. Duley's land, thence North 85 deg. 11' West 270.1 feet, thence S. O deg. 10' West 297.8 feet, more or less to the North line of Tualatin Mill Company's land, thence East 269.2 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.695 acres, more or less.
