# To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, C. G. Godlove (Name of applicant)  
of Murphy, Rt. 1, Box 141 (Mailing address),  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Big Applegate (Name of stream),  
a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25  
cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

### Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 8 feet, length on top 100 feet, length at bottom  
100 feet; material to be used and character of construction lumber, dirt and rocks  
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry,  
rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate direct, with regulation 1/4 mile below.  
(Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 3" Cent. powered by 22 H.P. gas  
(Size and type of pump)  
engine from Ford Tractor, 10 ft. lift from sump filled from ditch.  
(Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

\*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

\*\*Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Big Applegate River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 30, 1948

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 30, 1949 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1950

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1951
