

* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Frank Rada (Name of applicant) of Mill City, Oregon (Mailing address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is springs (Name of stream) a tributary of North Santiam

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2 1/2 gallon per minute cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic use (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 600 ft. S. (N. or S.) and 50 ft. W. (E. or W.) from the NE Corner of Southwest 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Section 30, Tp. 9 S., R. 3 E., W.M. Marion Co., Oregon. (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NE 1/4 (Give smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 30, Tp. 9 S., R. 3 E., W.M., in the county of Marion (E. or W.)

STATE OF OREGON, } ss County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.5 gallons per minute measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from 5 unnamed springs

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic, including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre domestic garden.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 8, 1948

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 30, 1949 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1950

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1951
