APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Fred Warner (Name of Applicant)

of Trail, P. O., County of Jackson

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is West Fork of Stewart Cr. known locally as Trail Cr. tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 10 miners inches cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located N 81° 40' W 1560 feet from the east quarter corner of Sec. 13 T 33 S R 2 W.W.M. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 33 S, R. 2 W, W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The main ditch to be 4300 feet miles in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 33 S, R. 1 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Fred Warner Ditch

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed one-fourth (0.25) cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is Dec. 29, 191³.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Feb. 20, 1915
and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1st, 1916

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct 1st, 1917
