* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, EARL WITHERS (Name of applicant) of BURNS (Mailing address), State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Middle Fork Rattlesnake Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Harney Basin

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 29 inches cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is IRRIGATION (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1320 ft. N and 780 ft. E from the SW corner of S. 30 Twp 22 S. Range 32 1/2 (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)

being within the Lot 4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 22 S., R. 32 1/2 E., W. M., in the county of Harney

5. The ditch to be 1000 feet in length, terminating in the Lot 4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 22 S., R. 32 1/2 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 0.73 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from _____

Middle Fork Rattlesnake Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per
second ~~or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a~~
~~diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during~~
~~the irrigation season of each year,~~

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
October 1, 1950
