I, Jesse A. Wilcoxon of Applegate General Delivery State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Big Applegate River, a tributary of Rogue River

SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed0.05..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from ...Big Applegate River.....

The use to which this water is to be applied isirrigation.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to1/80th..... of one cubic foot per
secondor its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a
diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,.....
