To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, General Development Co., R. W. Reppert, Secretary-Treasurer of Medford, P. O. Box 106, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rogue River, a tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3.09 cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation, stock, domestic with 1/2 ac. of lawn and garden for each domestic use.

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and ft. from the corner of S. 12° E. 1560 feet from the NE 1/4 corner of Section 13

being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The pipe line system to be 6000 ft. in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 Sec. 12 & NE 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.53 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Rogue River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation, stock and domestic, including irrigation of 1/2 acre domestic garden and lawn for each family, being 1.63 c.f.s. for irrigation, 0.24 c.f.s. for stock and 0.66 c.f.s. for domestic.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 28, 1948

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 17, 1950 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1950. Extended to Oct. 1, 1952. Extended to Oct. 1, 1957. Extended to Oct. 1, 1954.
