

\* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, OREGON STATE GAME COMMISSION (Name of applicant) of 616 Oregon Building, Portland 4, Oregon (Post office), County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Clear Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Willowa River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 18.0 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is State Trout Hatchery (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 980 ft. N. and 1766 ft. E. from the center corner of Sec. 3, T. 2 S., R. 41 E., W. M. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 18.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Clear Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is State Trout Hatchery

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 31, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 15, 1950 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1951

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1952
