# To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Frank Bates and Harry Renzleman  
(Name of applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

C. Jensen tract and being the center line of Three Rivers; thence south on the east line of said C. C. Jensen tract 1746.31 feet to the south line of the Lars Jensen Claim; thence south  $89^{\circ}28'$  east 916.7 feet along said south line; thence north 695.54 feet, more or less, to a point which is 1954.9 feet south and 1648.1 feet east of the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 11; thence north  $57^{\circ}10'$  east 337.9 feet to the Mattoon fence line; thence along said Mattoon fence line north  $21^{\circ}23'$  west 93.8 feet; thence north  $5^{\circ}23\frac{1}{2}'$  west 264.2 feet to an iron pin; thence north  $70^{\circ}08'$  east 163.94 feet to fence line of Albert Mason tract; thence north  $35^{\circ}$  east 313.74 feet along said fence line to center line of County road; thence north  $19^{\circ}40'$  west 451.3 feet along center line of County road to line of H. L. and D. Jensen; thence north  $89^{\circ}30'$  west 1304.54 feet along said line to C. C. Jensen line; thence south 208.6 feet to place of beginning; all in Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, Township 4, south of range 10, west of the Willamette Meridian.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and stock

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per  
second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 15, 1949

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 15, 1951 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
