To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.5 gallons per minute measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and use in restaurant

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 20, 1949

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 15, 1951 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1952

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1953
