

\* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R. B. WHITE and ROSE WHITE, his wife, of Box 1160, Roseburg, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Dear Creek, a tributary of the South Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one (1) cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation of land described under Paragraph 8 hereof.

4. The point of diversion is located 120 ft. East from the S.W. corner of lands described in Paragraph 8. However, pumping system is movable anywhere along the South side of said land.

being within the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 22, Tp. 27 S., R. 5 W., W. M., in the county of Douglas, State of Oregon

5. The pipe line to be about 400 ft. in length, terminating in the same property of Sec. , Tp. , R. , W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

WHITE AND ROSE WHITE, his wife, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said ROBERT B. WHITE and ROSE WHITE, as husband and wife and as an estate by the entirety, their heirs and assigns, all the following real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances situated in the County of Douglas and State of Oregon, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point which is in the S. line of the Deer Creek Road and which is 107.0 ft. South and 198.0 ft. East of the Southwest Corner of Lot 12, Plat A, Deer Creek Orchard Tract; thence running South 88° East 340.0 ft. along the South line of said road to a point; thence South 13° 30' West 200.0 ft. to a point in the center of Deer Creek; thence following the meanders of said creek, down stream, North 80° West 135.0 ft., South 85° West 100.0 ft. and South 60° West 98.0 ft; thence leaving said creek and running North 7° East 240.0 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 1.5 acres, more or less, and situated in Twp. 27 South, Range 5 W. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Deer Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per  
second ~~or its equivalent for each acre irrigated~~ and shall be further limited to a  
~~diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the~~  
~~irrigation season of each year.~~

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 15, 1951 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
