To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, MT. JEFFERSON LUMBER CO. of LYONS, OREGON State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed, a tributary of Trask Creek - North Santiam River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.10 cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Mill Pond Reservoir

4. The point of diversion is located 1100 ft. N. and 40 ft. W. from the 1/4 corner #4 on the south side of Section 19.

5. The Pipeline to be 750 ft. in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 9 S, R. 2 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is Maintenance of a mill pond described in  
Application No. R-24116, Permit No. R-999.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per
