To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Earl Parrish, Leslie Parrish, William Parrish and Arthur Parrish (Name of applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic, including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre for each family.

providing that the capacity of the system used to deliver water as proposed in this appropriation is not increased over that in use February 28, 1950.

The priority date of this permit is August 22, 1949

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1951 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1952

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1953
