

* APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R. L. Morrow (Name of applicant) of Marial, Curry County (Mailing address), State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Jackson Creek sometimes known as Johnson Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic and 1/2 acre of garden. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located S. 63° W. 950 feet West (N. or S.) and ft. (E. or W.) from the N. E. corner of Section 25 (Section or subdivision)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Jackson Creek (sometimes known as Johnson Creek)

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic, including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 15, 1950

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1951 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1952

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1953
