To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

State of _____, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

Members are the authorized agents of the incorporated Cities of Coos Bay and North Bend

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Pony Creek and Upper Pony Creek Reservoir (Name of stream), a tributary of Pony Slough and Coos Bay

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 15 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Municipal (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 380 ft. S. (N. or S.) and 350 ft. E. (E. or W.) from the N.W. corner of S.W./4 of S.W./4 Section 28 T. 25S, R. 13W, W.M. (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NW/4, SW/4, SW/4 (Give smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 28, Tp. 25S (N. or S.), R. 13W (E. or W.), W. M., in the county of Coos

5. The pipe line thru dam (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 220 feet (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NW/4, SW/4, SW/4 (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 28, Tp. 25S (N. or S.), R. 13W (E. or W.), W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 45 feet, length on top 380 feet, length at bottom 100+ feet; material to be used and character of construction sandy clay (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate 36" Square cast iron (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description _____ (Size and type of pump)

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON, County of Marion, ss.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 15.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Pony Creek and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-24922, Permit No. R-1064

The use to which this water is to be applied is municipal

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 11, 1950

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 31, 1952 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1952 Extended to Oct. 1, 1960

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1953 Extended to Oct. 1, 1960
