APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Clayton S. Berkey for Berkey Lumber Co. of Box 1017 West Main St. - Sheridan State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.11 cubic feet per second.

4. The point of diversion is located 110 ft. S and 369 ft. W from the SW corner of Lot No. 50 of Bowley Land Plat

being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 34, Tp. 5 S, R. 6 W, W. M., in the county of Yamhill

5. The Pipeline to be 2.75 in length, terminating in the of Sec. 34, Tp. 5 S, R. 6 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Yamhill River and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-24910, Permit No. R-1129.

The use to which this water is to be applied is maintenance of a log pond and irrigation, being 0.097 c.f.s. for pond and 0.013 c.f.s. for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 23, 1950

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 16, 1952 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1954
