

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, B. J. Woodward (Name of applicant)
of Rt. #1, Box 115, Mulino, (Mailing address)
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Kolalla River (Name of stream), a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.00 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 918.30 ft. N. and 107.12 ft. from the corner of Section 22, Township 7 North, Range 4 East of the Willamette Meridian (Section or subdivision). (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SE of the 1/4 of Sec. 22, Tp. 7N, R. 4E, W. M., in the county of Wasco (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

D. and Hulda French and recorded on May 24, 1907 in Book 99, Page 354, Record of Deeds for Clackamas County, Oregon, to the place of beginning of the tract herein described, including all the riparian rights now owned by Clackamas County adjacent thereto, excepting therefrom the rights of the public in and to the 60 foot right of way of the Oregon City-Silverton State Highway.

Also conveying the following strip of land 20.00 feet on each side of the following described center line as described in Book 227, Page 207, Record of Deeds for Clackamas County, Oregon.

Beginning at a point in the north boundary of the Harrison Wright Claim No. 38, Township 4 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian that is West 433.42 feet distant from the northeast corner of said claim; thence South 1° 24' East 41.10 feet along the Oregon City-Silverton State Highway; thence South 19° 17' East 75.73 feet to a point of curve; thence along a 6° curve to the left, thru a central angle of 12° 30', a distance of 208.33 feet to a point of tangent; thence South 31° 47' East 37.12 feet to a point of curve; thence along a 200° curve to the right, thru a central angle of 122° 30', a distance of 61.25 feet to a point of tangent; thence North 89° 17' West 117.52 feet for a terminus under the northerly approach to Wrights Bridge.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.262 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Molalla River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 28, 1950

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 16, 1952 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1954
