

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, David H. Johnson of Warren State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Southouse, a tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.30 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 2000 ft. South and 1000 ft. East from the corner of Jacob Nessley Donation Land Claim

being within the N.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 4N., R. 1W., W. M., in the county of Columbia

5. The line to be 2000 in length, terminating in the N.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 4N., R. 1W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

Beginning at a point on the division line between Section 29 in T. 4N. of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian and Section 30 in Township 4 North of Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, 384 feet South of the intersection of the said division line with the division line between the Joseph Stoughton and Jacob G. Nessly Donation Land Claim, which point of intersection is 1626.2 feet east of the Southwest corner of said Joseph Stoughton Donation Land Claim; and running thence South on said division line between Sections 29 and 30, 304 feet to a point; thence East on a line parallel with the said division line between said Donation Land Claims 4069.4 feet more or less to a point on the East line of the said Jacob G. Nessly Donation Land Claim; which point is 768 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Jacob G. Nessly Donation Land Claim; thence North on said East line of said Donation Land Claim 384 feet to a point; thence West parallel with said division line between the Donation Land Claims 813.4 feet to a point; thence S.47°12'W. 152.5 feet to a point; thence S.70°50'W. 131.5 feet to a point; thence N.78°19'W. 109.5 feet to a point; thence N.67°04'W. feet to a point; thence N.51°31'W. 59.2 feet to a point; thence N.68°07'W. 43.9 feet to a point; thence N.50°08'W. 64.5 feet to a point; thence West on a line parallel with the said division line between said Donation Land Claims 2725.7 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 54.9 acres, more or less, excepting therefrom the right-of-way of the Northern Pacific Railroad Company (now Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company) and subject to the rights of the public in and to the St. Helens Portland County Road across said land.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed0.299..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Scappoose Bay.....

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,.....

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 1, 1950.....

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 16, 1952..... and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1953.....

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before.....
