



APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Royal L. and Lois Henshaw, husband and wife of Rt. 1, Brownsville State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Calapooia River, a tributary of Willametta River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .23 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 2112 ft. S and 1914 ft. W from the corner of Section 36, Township 13 S, Range 3 W. W. II.

being within the SW 1/4 of Sec. 36, Tp. 13 S, R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Linn

5. The pipe line to be 7.0 feet in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 36, Tp. 13 S, R. 3 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of headgate

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 2 inch centrifugal pump powered by 7 1/2 H.P. single phase electric motor - 6 foot lift.

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. **Application for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.



Beginning on the East line of the Donation Land Claim of Elias L. Walters and wife, Notification No. 2134, and Claim No. 38 in Township 13, South Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian at a point which is 17.55 chains South of the Northeast corner of said Donation Land Claim and running thence North 17.55 chains to the Northeast corner of said Claim No. 38, thence West 13.34 chains, more or less to the Northwest corner of the North Projection of said Claim No. 38, thence South 5.93 chains, more or less, to the Southeast corner of the Donation Land Claim of Nathaniel D. Jack, Claim No. 40 in said Township and Range, thence East 20 feet, thence South 11.32 chains to a point 20 feet North of a line ~~beginning~~ West from the place of beginning, thence East 1.397 chains to a point 11.64 chains West of the East boundary line of said Donation Land Claim of Elias L. Walters and wife, thence South 20 feet, thence East 11.64 chains to the place of beginning containing 23.03 ac embre or less, all lying in and being in Linn County, Oregon

Beginning at a point on the East boundary line of the D.L.C. of Elias L. Walter, Not. No. 2134, Claim No. 38, in Twp. 13 S.R. 3 W of the Willamette Meridian in Linn County, Oregon, which is 17.55 chains South of the NE corner of said claim and from thence run South on the East boundary line of said claim 16.45 chains to the center of the Calapooia River; thence West 3.00 chains; thence South 42° West 5.78 chains; thence South 35° E. 5.90 chains; thence West 6.00 chains; thence North 35° West 3.75 chains down the center on said Calapooia River; thence North to a point 11.64 chains west of beginning point; thence East 11.64 chains to beginning, containing 25 acres more or less.

Also, beginning in the West boundary of D.L.C. of Alexander Kirk and wife Not. 2136, Claim 37 in said township and range 19.30 chains south of the Northwest corner of said claim with intersection of said boundary with center line of the county road as described in that deed of W. S. Harrison and wife recorded at page 549 of Volume 134 of Deed Records of Linn County, Oregon; and from said beginning running southeasterly along the center of said present County Road parallel with and Northerly 7.50 feet distant from the therein described surveyed road, parallel with the following described courses and distances of the center line of said road from the West line of said claim as follows: - South 85° East 4.06 chains, to angle in said surveyed road, South $38^{\circ} 15'$ East 2.34 chains, and South $77^{\circ} 30'$ East 3.00 chains; thence Southerly 7.50 feet to a stake at angle of center line of said surveyed road set at end of course last mentioned in said surveyed road; thence East in the center line of the surveyed road, and parallel with North boundary of said claim 2.88 chains more or less to a point 30 feet West of an iron pin; thence East 30 feet to said iron pin, same being 11.75 chains East of West boundary of said claim and being the Northeast corner of a tract conveyed to J. H. Crawford by Ed Holloway and wife by deed recorded at page 226 of Volume 89 of said deed, records; thence South 0.85 chains to an iron pin on the right bank of the Calapooia River; thence following meanders of right bank of said river down stream as described in said deed recorded at page 549 of Volume 134 of said Deed Records to the West boundary of said claim; thence North along the West boundary of said claim 11.75 chains to beginning point, containing 14.43 acres more or less. Also, beginning at said iron pin set on right bank of the Calapooia River at intersection of a line drawn south of parallel with and 26.86 chains distant from the North boundary of said claim with a line drawn East of A parallel with and 11.75 chains distant from the West boundary of said claim, and running thence South to the center of the main channel of said river; thence down the middle of the main channel of said river to its intersection with the West boundary of said claim; thence North on West boundary of said claim to the Southwest corner of said tract last described above, being a point 31.05 chains south of the Northwest corner of said claim; thence following the meanders of the right bank of said river, up stream, along the boundaries of the tract last above described to beginning, and all being in Linn County, State of Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.224 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Calapooya River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 16, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 16, 1952 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1954
