

\*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Perkins Veneer Company of 315 West Broadway, Eugene, Oregon State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation January 4, 1951 Eugene, Oregon

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Deer Creek south a tributary of Umpqua

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.06 cubic feet per second

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Log Pond

4. The point of diversion is located 1085 ft. N and 2165 ft. W from the SE corner of Section 15, Township 27 South, Range 5 West

being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 27 S

R. SW W. M. in the county of Douglas

5. The pipe 4" to be 435 ft. in length, terminating in the SW SE of Sec. 15, Tp. 27 S

R. SW W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Dear Creek and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-25931, Permit No. R-1168.

The use to which this water is to be applied is maintenance of a log pond.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 14, 1951 for 0.02 cfs & June 4, 1951 for 0.04 cfs.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 16, 1952 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1954
