

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Howard Martin of Rt 1 Box 430 Clackamas State of Oregon do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Dean Creek (trib. at Kelley Cr.), a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.04 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 30 ft S and 640 ft E from the NW 1/4 corner of Sec. 4

being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 4, Tp. 4 S R. 2 E, W. M. in the county of Clackamas

5. The main ditch, canal or pipe line to be in length, terminating in the of Sec. 4, Tp. 4 S R. 2 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

Beginning at the 1/4 section corner on the west boundary of Section 4, T. 2 S. R. 2 E. of W.M., thence N. 0 degrees 24' W. a distance of 126.6 feet to an iron pipe driven in the north boundary of the Wm. T. Matlock D.L.C.; thence N. 68 degrees 38' E. tracing the north boundary line of said D.L.C. a distance of 454.6 feet to a point on the easterly right of way line of the Cascade Highway, said point being the true point of beginning; thence N. 68 degrees 38' E. along the North boundary line of said Matlock D.L.C. a distance of 164.3 feet to center of 82nd St. County Road; thence tracing the center of said road S. 33 degrees 56' E. a distance of 499.8 feet; thence S. 55 degrees 56' W. a distance of 294 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 33 degrees 56' W. a distance of 145.4 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 55 degrees 56' W. a distance of 7.2 feet to the easterly right of way line of the Cascade Highway; thence along said Highway right of way line as follows:—on an arc 1352.4 feet radius curve to the right (the long chord of which curve bears N. 14 degrees 43' W. 33.4 feet) a distance of 33.4 feet; thence N. 14 degrees 01' W. a distance of 382.1 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.95 acres, more or less, exclusive of railroad right of way and public roads.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.037 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Dean Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/100th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 2, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 16, 1952 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1954
