

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

Beginning at a point which is the intersection of the North and South quarter section line of Section 23, T. 4 S., R. 1 W of the W.M., with the westerly line of the Oregon and California Railway right of way and 182.00 feet south of the center of said Section 23; thence in a northwesterly direction to an iron bar which is on the East and West quarter section line of said Section 23 and 132.00 feet west from the center of said Section; thence west with said quarter section line, 186.00 feet to an intersection with the easterly line of the Portland Eugene & Eastern Railway right of way; thence with the easterly line of said right of way in a northeasterly direction 1419.17 feet; being the northwesterly corner of the tract hereby described; thence east 466.00 feet to an intersection with the westerly line of the said Oregon & California Railway right of way; thence southeasterly with said west line of said right of way 1672.00 feet to the place of beginning; Also the following described tract of land, Beginning at the point on the westerly line of the Pacific Highway 600.00 feet southwesterly from the point of intersection of said westerly line of said Pacific Highway with the easterly line of the Oregon & California Railway right of way in the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 23, T. 4 S., R. 1 W.; thence northeasterly along said westerly line of Pacific Highway 600.00 feet to the intersection with the Easterly right of way line of the Oregon and California Railway; thence southwesterly along easterly line of said right of way 600.00 feet; thence southeasterly 61.00 feet to the place of beginning.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.113 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Mill Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/100th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 11, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 10, 1951 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1954
