

*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, F. L. Mathews (Name of applicant) of Myrtle Creek (Mailing address) State of Oregon do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Umpqua River (Name of stream) a tributary of Umpqua River
2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.6 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)
**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)
4. The point of diversion is located 83.6 ft. N. and 14.0 ft. E. from the corner of West boundary of section 7, T. 20. S., R. 2. W. (Section or subdivision)

being within the section of Sec. 7 Tp. 20 N. or S.
R. 2 W. M. in the county of Clatsop
5. The pipeline (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 2400 ft. (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the section of Sec. 7 Tp. 20 N. or S. R. 2 W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

No 37 and 41, T 30 S., R 5 & 6 W., M. which is describes as follows: Beginning at a point on the north line of said Cowles D.L.C. which is indicated by a 1/2 in. iron pipe and which is 2062.3 ft. west of the southeast corner of the L. Bailey D.L.C. No. 47, T 30 S., R 5 W., M.

Thence running S 0°27'W 1230.7 ft. to a 1/2 in. iron pipe;

Thence S 89°57'W 1302.0 ft. to a point;

Thence N 23°46'W 333.9 ft., N 1°57'W 59.9 ft., S 80°41'W 49.5 ft., N 27°21'W 171.4 ft., N 23°06'W 120.0 ft., N 14°20'W 24.3 ft., N 7°25'W 112.3 ft., N 7°05'E 72.3 ft., and N 40°53'W 236.6 ft. to the north line of said Cowles D.L.C.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.595 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and supplemental irrigation of not to exceed 47.6 acres.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 16, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 15, 1951 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1954
