

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed & Sailing Creek and reservoir, a tributary of Sailing Creek & Nesyuca River
2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .03 cubic feet per second. 1 C.F. for Fish Culture
3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic & Fish Culture

4. The point of diversion is located 3750.56 ft. N and 122.28 ft. E from the S.W. corner of SE 1/4 section 36 Twp. 3 S. R. 10 W. W. M. Tillamook, Oregon

being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 & SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 36 Tp. 3 S. R. 10 W. W. M., in the county of Tillamook

5. The pipe line to be 1800 ft in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 36 Tp. 3 S. R. 10 W. W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed creek, and reservoirs to be constructed under Application No. 2-24717, Permit No. 2-1185

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and fish culture, being 0.3 c.f.s. for domestic and 1.00 c.f.s. for fish culture

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 11, 1951

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1952 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
