This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from [redacted] to be constructed under Application No. R-25902, Permit No. R-1213

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/20th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated or to be irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1/2 acre foot per acre for each acre to be irrigated during the irrigation season of each year [redacted] to be constructed under Permit No. R-1213; provided further that the total amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other permit [redacted] the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.
