APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, GEORGE D. REYNOLDS (Name of applicant) of FLORENCE NORTH FORK N. (Mailing address) State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is UNLAWFUL TRENCH (Name of stream), a tributary of NICHOLS
