

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Benjamin R. Jaskey of Pt. 2, Box 103 State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mill Creek, a tributary of Pudding River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 296 ft. S and 175 ft. W from the N.E. corner of J. Grim D.L.C.

being within the 10 of Sec. 10, Tp. 4 20th R. 1 West, W. M., in the county of Marion

5. The pipe line to be 270' main 300' lateral in length, terminating in the 10 of Sec. 10, Tp. 4 South, R. 1 West W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.175 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 30 cfs of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be for the purpose of irrigation of not to exceed 20 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated and shall be for the purpose of irrigation of each tract,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
